

## Grant Awards Allow for Important Program Expansions

*Federal and local dollars to reach more children with bigger impact*

The Consortium for Resilient Young Children (with The Children's Home as its fiscal agent) has been awarded a two-year, \$325,000 grant from the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky Social Innovation Fund (SIF). The grant will be used to expand kindergarten readiness programming to young, at-risk children.

SIF is a unique partnership between the federal Corporation for National and Community Service and 14 local funders to identify and support innovative and effective solutions for children and young adults in Cincinnati, Covington, and Newport. After a competitive proposal process, the Consortium was one of only nine local organizations to receive part of \$1.7 million in funding. The Consortium consists of the following partners:
