

Camp-I-Can

Thank you for your interest in Camp-I-Can, our enriching summer day camp for children. We have compiled this information regarding our procedures to cover the most commonly asked questions. About the Program:

Camp-I-Can is a co-ed, summer day camp for children ages 5 to 12. Campers participate in a variety of activities including swimming, recreation, games, arts and crafts, music, outdoor and indoor activities and exciting field trips. Breakfast, lunch, and snack are provided daily.

Orientation:

At least one parent or guardian must attend an orientation meeting before any child can begin camp. There will be two meeting times offered for your convenience. Please contact us for dates and times.

Dates:

Camp will run for a continuous ten weeks during the summer. Please consider this commitment before you sign your child/children up for camp. Camp will be closed on July 4th (or the legal holiday) in observance of Independence Day.

Registration:

Before your child can become enrolled in Camp-I-Can, you must first complete the registration packet. You must also include a copy of your child's immunization record showing a negative TB test after age one. Your packet must be complete before it can be processed.
